
Award for Aspirations in Computing Opportunity - Grade 9-12 students





The Award for Aspirations in Computing (AiC) honours Grade students who self-identify as women, gender-queer, or non-binary for their computing-related achievements and interests, and encourages them to pursue their passions.

This award does not require any technical, previous experience but rather focuses on their deep passion for technology. Recipients of the NCWIT AiC receive access to a community of more than 20,000 technical women and exclusive opportunities.

Traditionally this awards ceremony was exclusively offered in the United States, but recently they have opened up applications to Canadian students. We're representing Western Canada and would love your support in promoting this opportunity to high school students.
